Pinot Noir Des Trois

Our initial Pinot Noir releases sourced grapes from the country's three best regions: Central Otago, Waipara and the Wairarapa, from three of our favourite producers - hence the wine's name. Having now learnt a great deal about making Pinot, we have narrowed the choice of vineyards down to two parcels in Martinborough and locally in Te Awanga.

WINEMAKING NOTES

The wine was hand plunged then sealed for extended maceration. The wine was gently pressed and matured in French oak barrels. Some of the wine was left on light yeast lees for eight months for extra body. The wine was gently racked and lightly fined with free range egg whites before bottling unfiltered. Cherry, mocha and red berries dominate the front palate, underpinned with a brambly, earthy solidity of ripe tannins and cedary oak.
